Winter Exam preparation

You will be pleased to know that teachers will be available from 2:30 until 16:00 in the afternoons for additional support. Students need to contact the teachers during class time or email the year leader whom will coordinate with the teachers. Teachers have different stay back days, so coordination is vitally important. This service has been available all year; however, students have not used it as it was intended. Bus transport during exams will only be available for year 11 students whom have paid for this service. Both North and South buses will be available on those days. Year 10 Exams

Please note that the year 10 winter examinations will be conducted ONLINE at home. This decision was taken considering all aspects of social distancing etc. which may have complicated arrangements at school. Your children's health and safety is our main priority. There may be some subjects where the teachers will require the students in year 10 to come to school. These exams will be arranged directly by the concerned staff.

Revised WINTER EXAM TIMETABLE

Due to the 29th and 30th that will be complete ONLINE days for the whole school, we decided to change the Timetable for the exams to support other operational arrangements made by the school. Please take note of the changes made to the 29th and 30th of November on the exam Timetable. Class attendance

It was observed that many students are not attending their online classes on a regular basis. Teachers and form teachers have been phoning parents but in some cases students are still not attending. Please monitor your child's attendance.



Devices for exams

Parents please take note that it is your responsibility to provide your child with the correct device for the online teaching and exams. Students will have to be able to print and scan their work as was the case last year. At this stage I am sure all students are aware of the fact that all cameras must be turned on during the exams. Failing to do so will result in your child being disqualified from the exam. If we suspect children from cheating we, may require the rewrite of such a subject at school.

Year 11 IGCSE exam entries

The IGCSE exam entries will be concluded this week. The deadline was 12/11/2020 for internal registration. For any further queries regarding the dropping of subjects, we urge you to get hold of Ms. Pricilla on her email. Thank you for the online information session managed by Mr. Shaheer and Ms. Pricilla to discuss the subject choices for the various countries. If any Year 10 students qualify to enroll for IGCSE exams, they will be contacted individually.

VPN Applications

Since yesterday all VPN applications are banned in the school. I personally spoke to all online as well as the BL students present in school yesterday. SHOULD STUDENTS BE CAUGHT WITH THIS ON A DEVICE AT SCHOOL, WE WILL CONFISCATE THE DEVICE FROM STUDENTS AND IT MAY NOT BE RETURNED. We had major problems at school with students using these applications to access inappropriate sites and to have access to social media. I urge parents to go through the devices at home and to delete all VPNs.
