# **WINTER EXAMS**

You will be pleased to know that teachers will be available from 2:30 until 16:00 in the afternoons for additional support. Students need to contact the teachers. Bus transport during exams will only be available for year 11 students, whom have paid for this service. Both North and South buses will be available on those days. Consult with Mr. Atef for further details. Please take note of these arrangements for the ONLINE exams:

- Parents MUST make sure that all students have the correct devices, must be able to scan where
  necessary and have the correct software. If you are not sure, please ask the teacher and year
  leaders
- Students **MUST** have their cameras on during exams.
- Students MUST be alone during the exams.
- The papers will be placed on Google Classroom by the teachers at the latest 8:20 in the morning.



- Students will have 10 minutes to scan over the paper and ask final questions before starting the exams at 8:30
- Please make sure the whole paper is scanned and sent to the teachers as and where required after completion.
- Students will only have 10 minutes after the exams to hand in their exam sheets. Sending it in late or sending to the incorrect platform, will result in a disqualification from that exam!
- Absenteeism will not be tolerated and students will NOT get class averages etc. There will be NO
  make-up exams etc.!! A doctors' note will be required, stamped and attested by the DHA in case
  of a medical emergency.
- Please check the timings of the different papers! Some days have two sessions.
- If we suspect the students are receiving help, we will notify the HOS and teacher concerned immediately and the child's exams will be cancelled. I urge parents to assist the school by upholding the integrity of the exams.
- It was fortunate / unfortunate that we have a week in the middle of the exams created by public holidays, I urge our students to use this time wisely!
- Year 11 students must make sure they arrive at school and seated at 8:15 for their exams to start at 8:30. WHEN LISTENING TESTS ARE CONDUCTED, STUDENTS MUST BRING THEIR OWN DEVICES AND HEADSETS!!
