Important Notices

1. GL Progress Tests

GL progress tests for the Blended Learners are completed today 12th November 2020. These tests will continue as per the schedule for the Distanced Learners by the end of the next week. Bringing their own headphones or earphones is also compulsory as they have parts of the tests with audio instructions.

2. Revised Winter Assessment Notice
