Important Notices

1. Winter Examination 2020

The Winter Examinations are starting on Sunday 22nd November 2020. We hope that everyone has received the revised schedule and started preparing accordingly. Some important points to note are:

Year 7,8,9, and 10 students will write these exams online from home. Please make sure that required compatible devices are available. Students are to login at 7:45 am to attend the form tutor's period. All important instructions will be shared during this period.

Question papers will be posted on the subject teacher's Google Classroom platform at 8:20 am. The exam begins at 8:30 am sharp. The 10 minutes duration is given to download and convert the papers in editable forms as per the subject teacher's instructions. Students are free to ask questions to the form tutors during this time should they have any doubts.

All students must be in the invigilation meeting by 8:30 with their cameras turned on. Examination taken without cameras will not be accepted.

Please make sure that there is no movement and disturbance in the background while the assessment is ongoing.

Completed answer scripts are to be submitted as per the subject teacher's instructions in the given time. No responses would be accepted after this time and the exam attempt would be disqualified. All attachments are to be thoroughly checked before sending. No requests and no resending of papers would be entertained thereafter.

Malpractice will result into disqualification of exam.

All Year 11 students must come to school to write their Winter Examination. Own transportation students must report to school by 8:00 am so that they are all settled by 8:15am for the exam. Exam begins at 8:30 am. Students those who have already paid for the school transportation would be able to avail this service. Students from both the North and the South zone would have the bus facility available everyday. Students must come in proper school uniform when they come to write any exam.

For Year 10, there may be some subjects where they will be required to come to school. This will be directly informed and organised by the relevant department.

Due to the fact that 29th and 30th November will be complete online days for all years, some changes were made to the Winter Exam schedule. Kindly make a careful note of these changes. The revised schedule is already uploaded on the website and on all the virtual classroom platforms.
