**COMPLETING THE LEARNING PROGRAM FOR THIS ACADEMIC YEAR**

It is very important that parents understand the necessity and importance to complete the whole academic year's learning program successfully to ensure that your child can be promoted to the next year group. The official end of this academic year is 1<sup>st</sup> July 2021. If parents choose to leave the country or remove their children from school before the end of the academic year their children will not be allowed to proceed to the next academic year. It will also have implications to obtain Transfer Certificates and end-of-year student report cards.

The Heads of Section are in contact with the relevant parents who may be impacted by this. Please consider your child's education as a priority, BEFORE making decisions for the future - immediate and longer-term.

**PENDING FEES**

Thank you to those parents who have responded positively on the request to clear their outstanding fees. We realise that everyone is facing tremendous challenges at the moment.

The next group of parents who are still in arrears with Term 2 and 3 tuition fees may find their children not to have access to the online learning program via Education from as early as next week. **ADMISSIONS FOR 2021-22 ACADEMIC YEAR**

We are pleased to inform you that the admissions for **siblings for Year 1 to Year 10** for Academic year 2021-2022 have been **opened**. The admission enquiry form is available on the school website. Please note that the admission confirmation would be on availability of seats and performance in the test in that particular year group.

For Year 1 and Year 2 there will be a written test in Basic English and Maths.

For Year 3 till Year 10 there will be a test in English, Math and Science.

**RE-REGISTRATION FOR 2021-22 ACADEMIC YEAR**

We are currently busy with the process to obtain approval from KHDA for the new academic year's school fee structure and also the revised wording for the Parent-School Contract. As soon as the school has these approvals in hand, we will notify parents of our current students of the date when re-registration will open for the 2021-2022 academic year.

For both new admissions and re-registration new procedures will be implemented due to the improved administrative software that AUS has introduced to improve the quality of our financial and admissions services. **It is important to note that no current students will be able to re-register for the new academic year without clearing any outstanding balances of previous years.**
