Dear parents and students,

KHDA APPROVED LEARNING MODELS IN AUS FOR 2021-22

The following two learning models have been approved for the next academic year:

Full-time In-School every day

- The school must abide by the occupancy restrictions determined by KHDA, DHA and DM at that time
- Due to the current social distancing restrictions, we anticipate that only 50% of our students will be allowed in the classrooms when school starts on 29th August 2021
- Nearly 60% of our parents indicated that they would prefer their children to attend the full-time In-School program every day in the new academic year
- To allow everyone a fair opportunity to secure their seats for the In-School program, **the first 50% of students who re-register and pay the 1st Instalment (as per the relevant attached Fee Structures)** for the new academic year will secure their seats for the full-time In-School model
- **The other students who would have preferred the In-School program will be placed on a waiting list and will be expected to continue their learning from home** with the rest their peers who are on the full-time Distance Learning program
- As the restrictions are lifted, the school will react appropriately to allow more students into the In-School program as permitted at that time
- Bus transport provided by the school must be arranged at the time of re-registration with our bus transport manager, Mr Atef

Full-time Distance Learning every day

- Students opting for this model, will not attend school for lessons, but access the live lessons via Zoom using the Edunation App
- These students will be expected to write end-of-term exams and external standardisation exams in the school to ensure the integrity of these assessments
- PLEASE NOTE: All students who could not secure their seats for full-time In-School, as explained above, will have to follow the full-time DL model

IMPORTANT NOTE: Parents will register their final choice of the model they prefer for every student via the online Fee Structure Agreement that can be accessed from the links below:

APPROVED FEE STRUCTURE FOR 2021-22 AND RE-REGISTRATION PROCESS

THE DEADLINE FOR RE-REGISTRATION IS 30 JUNE 2021. AFTER THIS DATE NEW ADMISSIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM OTHER SCHOOLS AND OUR UNREGISTERED STUDENTS WILL BE PLACED ON A WAITING LIST.

AUS has received KHDA approval for the new academic year's (2021-22) fee structure. **The approved fee structure documents for each year group are now available on both the school website and Edunation and will also be available for your reference via the links shared above.**

The process below should be followed for re-registration for the next academic year 2021-22:

- Make sure to clear all outstanding fees BEFORE starting the re-registration process for the 2021-22 academic year
- **Re-registration for the 2021-22 academic year will only be accepted after all outstanding fees have been cleared till the end of the current academic year**
- Complete and submit the online **Arab Unity School and Parent Agreement form** available from Edunation, or via the school website or via the links shared above
- **This form will allow you to**
 - indicate your choice of the Learning Model for the 2021-22 academic year
 - observe an overview of the approved fees for your child for 2021-22
 - accept to pay the appropriate year group's fees for your child
- After submitting this online **Arab Unity School and Parent Agreement form**, please allow **two (2) working days** BEFORE proceeding with the payment using the option of your choice
- The Skiplly online payment gateway will be updated accordingly to allow our parents, whom have cleared all outstanding fees, to do the payment for the 2021-22 re-registration
