Explanation Comments to explain the newly approved School Fee Structure for 2021-22

The changes in comparison with the previous academic year are as follows:

1. The new School Fee Structure document for 2021-22 has been redesigned to explain the fees more clearly than before. Each year group's fee structure is available via the links provided on Education and the school website on the Arab Unity School and Parent Agreement document.
2. **BOOK FEES:** AUS received approval to add the KHDA approved book/resources fees for UK Curriculum schools with the approved tuition fees. In the past, these fees were paid separately, and it caused a lot of administrative pressure on the school and the parents to collect these fees separately and to distribute the books/resources to the parents one-by-one. For the new academic year, the book/resource fees are included with the tuition fees, all books/resources (e.g. unique usernames and passwords for the e-resources) will be provided to the students during the first week of every term without the need for parents to visit the school again. The e-resources that will be introduced from 2021-22 are payable annually and textbooks for the Ministry of Education subjects are newly acquired for every year group every year. This will also benefit all when considering the COVID-19 protocols that need to be followed to avoid the spread of infection as far as possible.
Hope this clarifies.
3. **STANDARDISED ASSESSMENT FEES:** Arab Unity School (AUS) has previously received approval of AED500 per student for standardised testing. The GL Progress Tests (English, Math, Science) are charged at AED300 per student and the GL CAT4 assessments are charged at AED200 per student. These amounts are only charged for the relevant year groups' students.
4. **READING ASSESSMENT AND DEVELOPMENT FEES:** The previous two DSIB school inspection reports have recommended that the school has a more strategic and structured approach to assessing and developing students' reading skills. The school has found a recognized organisation, that has been working with other Dubai schools very successfully, that can provide more than one Reading Level Assessment per academic year (AY) and also collaborates with the school with bespoke intervention and support programs where students need additional support or challenge. This service is added to the fee structure at a cost of AED100 per student for Y1-Y10 students.
5. **EXTRA-CURRICULAR FEES:** The previously approved **Extra-Curricular fee of AED500** will only be charged for students who will follow the **full-time in-school** model in 2021-22 as the school will God willing continue with all the extra-curricular activities from the start of the new academic year.
The amount will be reduced to **AED100** for those students who follow **the full-time Distance Learning** model, due to the fact that they will only be engaged in the proceedings online. Our DL students' submissions of projects and other competition feedback will be printed by the school and assessed with their peers who are in school to allow proper engagement from all our students. They will also receive electronically generated rewards and certificates in contrast with students who are physically present at any of these events. If so preferred, the DL students' parents will be invited to come and collect any medals, certificates and other awards from the school if their child wins any of these competitions or receive motivational awards from his/her teachers.



6. **ICT FEES:** As you are aware, the school has invested and is still investing in continuous improvement of the ICT facilities and software. The additional costs to the school for new access points to improve the internet access and the Edunation Learning Management portal, iSAMS student registration portal and other very valuable additions to streamline our technology provision are all covered by this ICT fee. The AED600 fee for ICT will remain the same for those students opting for the full-time in-school model. The amount will be increased to AED800 for those who follow a full-time Distance Learning program due to additional resources and assessment tools that will be used for these students to provide a quality service and ensure the integrity of online assessments.
7. **CAMBRIDGE EXAM FEES:** The external exam fees for IGCSE (Y11), AS (Y12) and AL (Y13) students are now reflecting on the school fee structure in contrast with previous years where we did not share this information with parents on this document at the start of the AY.
8. Parents can pay their annual fees in up to three instalments by the deadlines indicated on the Fee Structure document.
9. The **Y12+13 (AS/AL) students** finish their academic year earlier than other students and have to pay their AS/AL external exam fees by the end of December. It is very difficult to obtain final payments for these students after they've left the school to prepare for their preparations for the final examinations and therefore, we prefer their annual fees to spread over a **maximum of two instalments**.
