SPRING BREAK DATES

School will close for Spring Break on Friday 25th of March and will open again for Term 3 on Monday 11th of April. The administrative offices will remain open during this time for admissions and payments. Please stay safe and healthy during this break.

RAMADAN SCHOOL TIMINGS

Ramadan is scheduled to start on the 2nd of April this year and when students and staff return for Term 3, the KHDA approved school timings will be followed as shared below. These times will be followed to abide by the KHDA requirements of a shortened day to accommodate fasting students and staff during this important time of reflection and prayers.

Mondays – Thursdays:

7.30AM till 12.30PM (Gates for own transport students will open at 12.45pm) Fridays:

7.30AM till 11.30AM (Gates for own transport students will open at 11.45am)

#NOTE: The FS2 students will follow the same school timings during Ramadan, but please refer to separate communication from Ms Elza (Head of FS) to confirm arrangements for FS2.

RE-REGISTRATION FOR 2022-23 ACADEMIC YEAR OPENS AFTER SPRING BREAK

The re-registration of our current students for the 2022-23 academic year will start after the Spring Break. A separate link will be made available on the new school website to initiate the re-registration process. No reregistration application will be accepted before all previous outstanding fees have not been cleared. Please make sure to clear all pending fees by the latest 30th of April. After this date, no seats will be reserved for the next academic year for current students when pending fees have not been cleared or official arrangements with the Finance Manager have not been agreed. This will allow the Admissions Officer to enroll the growing number of new admission applicants to plan more efficiently for the new academic year.
