SCHOOL TIMINGS FOR RAMADAN AND AFTER EID BREAK

These times will be continued till the end of Ramadan to abide by the KHDA requirements of a shortened day to accommodate fasting students and staff during this important time of reflection and prayers.

Mondays – Thursdays:**7.30AM till 12.30PM (Gates for own transport students will open at 12.45pm)****Fridays:****7.30AM till 11.30AM (Gates for own transport students will open at 11.45am)****PLEASE NOTE: After returning from the Eid break, the usual school timings will resume.****EID BREAK**

Newspapers have announced the Eid Al Fitr holidays for the UAE federal government employees that provides an indication of possible dates for schools. According to the Federal Authority For Government Human Resources, the break will be from Ramadan 29 to Shawwal 3. This year, Eid Al Fitr is expected to fall on May 2, as per astronomical calculations. Astronomically speaking, the likely dates of the holidays would be Saturday, April 30, till Wednesday, May 4.

When KHDA confirms the Eid-holiday dates for the private schools in Dubai, we will update everyone via Edu-Nation immediately.**RE-REGISTRATION FOR 2022-23 ACADEMIC YEAR**

Please take note that due to the upgrades in our systems, re-registration will **only be possible from Monday 9th of May.**

Students who are eligible to re-register for 2022-23, will receive a confirmation message on Edu-Nation to proceed with the process. For re-registration for the new academic year, no additional forms will need to be completed. The Accounts Department will NOT accept any re-registration fees if you have not received this confirmation message as explained above.

Please make sure to clear any outstanding fees by the latest Saturday, 30th of April, before 12pm as no seats will be reserved for the next academic year for current students when pending fees have not been cleared or official arrangements with the Finance Manager have not been agreed. This will allow the Admissions Officers to enroll the growing number of new admission applicants to plan more efficiently for the new academic year.
