KHDA PORTAL WITH SCHOOL FEES FACT SHEETS NOW AVAILABLE ON THE SCHOOL WEBSITE

As advertised in the press and other social media platforms, KHDA has requested all private schools in Dubai to submit all possible fees that may be applicable for the 2022-23 academic year. This will promote more transparency for parents to make more informed choices of schools for the next academic year.

Private schools in Dubai have now received confirmation from KHDA with regards to the fees for the 2022-23 academic year. The KHDA Fact Sheets and our school's own detailed AUS fee structures for all the respective year groups have been posted on the school's website for your reference:

You will notice from the AUS detailed fee structures that, although KHDA has approved an amount for uniforms in the mandatory category, AUS is NOT charging any uniform fees now. This fee may become relevant when the school uniforms are changed in the future.

You will also notice that the Extra-curricular Fee and the IT Fee (used for Technology & Cyber Security) have both been reduced significantly from previous years. Students with certain subject choices have additional fees (e.g. lab fees) relevant to them specifically.

The school is currently investing heavily in upgrading the number of and quality of equipment in an increased number of STEM labs across the school and more information regarding this initiative will be shared when we come back after the summer holidays.

Please make sure to clear any outstanding fees at the earliest if you have not received an eligibility message via Edunation yet. **Unfortunately, no seats will be reserved for the next academic year for current students when pending fees have not been cleared or official arrangements with the Finance Manager have not been agreed.** This will allow the Admissions Officers to enrol the steady flow of new admissions to plan more efficiently for the new academic year.

Fortunately, the school is in a good position to increase the number of classes in most year groups for the 2022-23 academic year.
